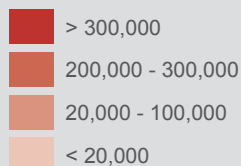




The Government of Haiti has confirmed the cholera outbreak. The disease has so far claimed **138** lives.¹ It is the first outbreak of cholera in Haiti in over 100 years.²

The cases have occurred in Saint-Marc, which is far from the main IDP camps and earthquake-affected areas.¹
